ENGLISH LANGUAGE ENHANCEMENT (ELE)

- Objective: To enhance the participant's English level throughout the study program.
- Schedule: Tuesdays & Thursdays (19:00 to 22:00).
- Instruction time: 260 academic hours.
- 80% of attendance is compulsory, though these classes do not influence the final grade.
